

# Our Assessment Approach

The stories and lived experiences of tamariki and rangatahi, their whānau, caregivers and community are at the centre of our monitoring approach.

We also talk with government organisations (such as Oranga Tamariki, Police, health and education), iwi and Māori organisations and community organisations, and those with care and custody of tamariki and rangatahi.

These voices of experience help us understand how well services are working together in a community to improve outcomes for tamariki and rangatahi.

Our assessment approach looks at whether positive outcomes are being achieved for tamariki and rangatahi, and the systems elements that enable, or are a barrier to, those outcomes.


